Overview

- Service delivery opportunities is a very important aspect of CHCT implementation.
- Organizations must look at what sites are best for their goals and the populations they want to reach.



Possible Places of CHCT Service Delivery

- VCT Centres
 - PMTCT
 - Home Based Care
 - Mobile Units
 - ART Sites
 - District Clinics
 - Fixed Sites

VCT/PMTCT Centres

- Disclosure difficult to partner.
- Information is given to only one partner.
- Risk reduction compliance issues.
- Child bearing and family planning issues are difficult to discuss with only one partner present.
- Support from partner is not present.
- However, promotion of CHCT at these sites can be very beneficial.



Home Based Care

- Could work well with some organizations.
- These organizations will have easier access to clients in that you go to their doorsteps to provide services.
- Clients can be comfortable with the environment.
- No transport costs.
- There may be fear of stigma and lack of privacy.



Mobile Units

- Mobile units can be model in that organizations are able to travel to the communities and offer CHCT services.
- Travel costs for clients is small.
- Usually held at churches, local hospitals, and other local community buildings.
- Must ensure promotions are properly done in order to make sure clients know the unit is visiting.



ART Sites

- Adherence can be poor due to lack of support.
- Issues regarding family planning because partner's status is unknown.
- However, can be an ideal site to promote CHCT in that not all clients who are currently on ARTs have partners who have also been tested.
- By promoting CHCT, you offer the partner with unknown status an opportunity to get tested as well.



District Clinics

- District clinics tend to offer these services and many more.
- Services offered can include the previous mentioned, as well as TB, cholera, family health, etc.
- Ideal to promote CHCT at these clinics in that organizations are working directly within a community.




District Clinics, cont

- ZEHRP currently works within 10 district clinics offering CHCT on the weekends.
- Able to promote within specific districts.
- Clients know where their district clinics are and therefore know where to go.



Fixed Sites

- Organizations can also work within their own fixed sites.
- Fixed sites can be opened within specific communities and promotion can occur within or outside of those communities.
- Staff feel comfortable with site.
- Organization is responsible for maintenance of site.
